Mountaineers Emergency Contact Procedures and Call Tree

Members of all branches/committees with a trip emergency should:

- 1) First call 911, and ask to be transferred to the Sheriff of the county they are in (or National Park Service for Rainier, Olympics, & North Cascades) for a Search and Rescue (SAR).
- 2) Second notify the club by calling the Mountaineers Emergency Line:

206-521-6030

This will bring the services of the Mountaineers organization to bear. The Mountaineers emergency contact can provide advice on managing through the incident, notify emergency contacts and relevant organization leadership, and serve as spokesperson for external organizations such as the media.

They will hear a message that says: "You have reached the Mountaineers Emergency Line. If you are currently involved in a Mountaineers activity-related emergency, please hang up and dial 911. If you have already notified 911, please stay on the line and you will be connected to the on-call Mountaineers emergency contact who can provide you with further assistance."
