Recreational Properties

Application

This standard applies to the use of club recreational properties and operation of lodges, including, but not limited to Baker Lodge, Kitsap Cabin, Meany Lodge, Snoqualmie Campus, and Stevens Lodge.

Permits

Recreational properties will maintain and display up-to-date permits as required by regulating agencies, including, but not limited to:

- Occupancy; if required by county or fire jurisdiction
- Food Service; issued by the applicable county health department
- Lifts and rope tows; issued by a state-certified inspector

Construction and Maintenance

New construction and maintenance work will be compliant with applicable building codes.

Each recreational property will inspect their grounds and facilities annually to confirm that they are in compliance with applicable regulations and to identify and repair damage as needed.

Food Handling

Food handling and meal preparation will be conducted in accordance with county health regulations.

When food is being prepared, the person in charge of food preparation must have a valid food handler's license.

Hosts

Lodge Committees will designate one or more Hosts whenever a lodge is open. The Host is in charge of lodge operations during the designated times.

Visitors (Members and Non-Members)

Each lodge visitor must have a signed waiver on file either at the Mountaineers Building or at the Lodge.

Visitors using lifts or rope tows are required to sign a waiver specific to that equipment before using it that season.

Activities

Club-sponsored hikes, snowshoe trips, backcountry skiing trips, alpine scrambles, climbs, or courses that originate at a recreational property must comply with the minimum clubwide standard applicable to the activity.

All other activities at the recreational property, such as privately-organized hikes, snow sports, games, etc. are not subject to other minimum clubwide standards.

All uses of a recreational property must be approved in advance by the applicable property committee chair or designee.

Standard Approval

This standard, and any revisions to it, must be approved by the Recreational Properties Division and majority approval of the Managing Committee.
