Global Adventures. Iceland July trip is a go. Several Covid-postponed trips (Peru, Patagonia (2X), Turkey, Norway, Japan) are TBD.

Activity Standards. Actions:

- >>Activity Councils & Summits staff support will resume late summer.
- >> Night Sky (astronomy) courses now listed after standards approval in May.
- >>**New Activity Councils** (FY2022) will include First Aid, Naturalists, Conservation & Stewardship and Sailing. All have (or will soon have) Basecamp presence. Chairs may request membership to Basecamps.

Stewardship Status. Peter provided 2018-2021 stewardship badge awards data. Clubwide only 11% of members were badged at least once over the 3.5 year period. Engagement is uneven across activities and branches. Actions:
