- Hiking <u>Standards</u>
 - Discussion: There was a midsummer revision to the definition of hiking by the Hiking Council that missed review by BLC.
 - Old definition: "Hikes in The Mountaineers are front-country or back-country hiking trips that take place outside of city or suburban parks, streets or greenbelts. When the hike is designed for youth clubs, outreach programs, or camps, it is a Youth Hike. When the hike is designed for families (children plus guardians), it is a Family Hike."
 - New definition: "Hikes in the mountaineers are front-country or back-country trips. When the hike is designed for youth clubs, outreach programs, or camps, it is a Youth Hike. When the hike is designed for families (children plus guardians), it is a Family Hike."
 - Discussion
 - Need to be careful about gatekeeping to keep leaders out of certain activities.
 - Issue about equity and inclusion to make sure leaders are treated fairly and leadership qualities are handled fairly.
 - Is there some way to make sure that hikes in the urban environment have leaders who have adequate safety training for the urban environment?
 - A branch can define within their charter standards and safety protocols to follow them.
