

Nearby Mormon Row Historic District Is Worth A Side-Trip Visit....






Trip Logistics


- National Park Permit Required; reservation at recreation.gov
- Advanced reservation accepted Feb-5 May-15 for 1/3 of sites
- Group Camps have bear lockers, except Alaska Basin
- Death Canyon Shelf Camp (2nd night) is a dry camp 8.1 miles from Lake Marian to next water
- 1.5 Hour round-trip Car staging shuttle from Teton Village to String Lake terminus before start of trip
- At end of trip, group stayed at Colter Bay Village
- Daytime temps 60s-70s; nighttime in the 40s


























