Looking for ways to have buy-in to include students as well as folks in positions of authority (instructors, brand chairs, etc.). Jack suggests working with AJ to collaborate on the post-trip surveys for Basic and Intermediate Course participants to get the word out. Audrey voiced that post-trip surveys would be very valuable to collect before the BSC materials review.

- Board of Directors (Tim Schafermeyer) Not present.
- Treasurer (Ryan Monahan) Winter is a high spending time period due to preparation for Basic and Intermediate course preparation. Presented typical annual expenses: branch budgets for approximately \$16,000 in expenses; branch budgets for approximately \$28,000 in revenue. Revenue is changing from historical numbers due to changes in Crag Course participation. Basic Course cost was reviewed in April/May to adjust for current pricing. Must adjust 2022 expenses to reflect club equipment purchases (new ice tools, new ropes, new radios, etc.). Discussed selling old materials to a local organization for upcycling. Jack Duffy asked about retaining revenue so that funds are not absorbed into the HQ if they aren't spent.
