BASIC NORDIC SKI TRIPS

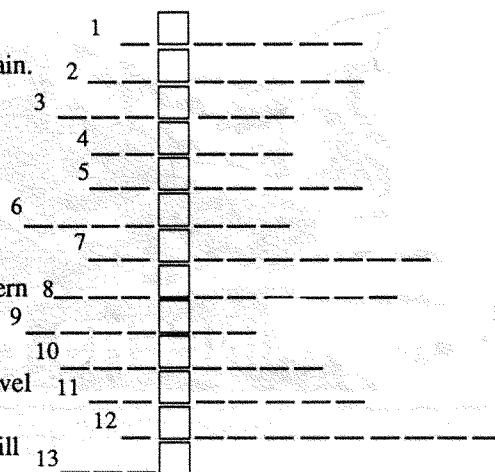
