

Must climb all peaks in the group and all climbs must have been after January 22, 1977. With respect for a request by the North Cascades National Park to minimize undue stress in sensitive alpine areas, climbers are asked to limit themselves to no more than three of these peaks per calendar year and to limit their climbing party to six members.
