The Alpine Scrambling Committee would like to thank all of you who led or participated in our Alpine Scrambling and Snowshoeing courses in the past year. The true success of these programs depends on your dedicated efforts and enthusiasm.

As part of our Volunteer Recognition Program, one can receive an incentive award for:

- Leading Scramble or Snowshoe Trips: Alpine Scrambling graduates are eligible to become Scramble or Snowshoe Trip leaders. This is a great way to create trips when and where you want to go, practice leadership skills, and build a network of mountaineering partners. There is an annual Trip Leader Orientation evening to help you get started. Interested scramblers will co-lead scrambles or snowshoe trips with a mentor to receive feedback on their skills and confirm their readiness to become a Scramble or Snowshoe leader.
- **Instructing at Scramble or Snowshoe Course Lectures or Field Trips:** Alpine Scrambling and Snowshoeing graduates are eligible to instruct at lectures or Field Trips. This is a great way to refresh the skills you learned in class. There is an annual Field Trip Instructor Orientation evening to help you get started. Veteran instructors are also needed to maintain the quality and continuity of the Scrambling and Snowshoeing Courses.
- Leading or Assisting Scramble or Snowshoe Field Trips: Alpine Scrambling and Snowshoeing graduates are eligible to lead or assist in organizing and running field trips. It is one of the best contributions you can make to the program and one of the ways to earn the most reward points.
- Serving on the Alpine Scrambling Committee: This is a great way to contribute to the program without getting cold and wet, whether by helping to organize the course schedule, coordinating lectures or field trips, or balancing the books.

The Award:

In appreciation to volunteers who make significant contributions to our Alpine Scrambling and Snowshoeing programs, the Alpine Scrambling Committee will award gift certificates for an annual Northwest Forest Pass or Discover Pass. Volunteers earning four or more points between January 1st and December 31st of the prior year will be eligible for one of the 20 awarded gift certificates.

Award points will be accumulated as follows:
