Everett Hiking Committee – How to Become a Hike Leader

Mentee Steps:

- 1. Attend a 2.5 hour <u>hike leader seminar</u> through one of the Mountaineers branches. Pre-requisites for the seminar are as follows:
 - Current Mountaineers member.
 - Completed 3 club day hikes. Exceptions can be made if you have participated in courses such as Climbing, Scrambling or Backpacking. Please reach out to <u>hiking@everettmountaineers.org</u> to request an exemption.
 - Please note that urban hikes cannot be used to meet the day hike requirements.
- 2. Complete the Low Impact Recreation Skills eLearning course.
- 3. Complete a <u>Hike leader application</u>.
- 4. Identify a mentor and request temporary hike leader status by sending an email to: <u>hiking@everettmountaineers.org</u>. If you need assistance identifying a mentor, send an email to <u>hiking@everettmountaineers.org</u> with the mentored hike you'd like to lead and the pace at which you intend to lead it.
- 5. Post and lead a mentored club day hike. The hike must meet the following criteria:
 - Hike must not be associated with a course.
 - Hike may not be an urban walk or hike.
 - Hike must be a minimum of 4 miles and 800ft in elevation gain.
 - Hike leader candidate must post the hike as the primary leader and register the mentor as the co-leader; hike should be posted under the Everett Hiking Committee.
 - Hike should be open to a minimum of 8 participants.
 - Hike must have a minimum 10-day sign-up window.
 - Hike should enable demonstration of the skills presented during the seminar.
- 6. Close the activity after completion.
- 7. Receive positive recommendation from mentor to be granted permanent hike leader status.
- 8. Everett hiking committee will inform you that you've met the requirements to become a hike leader and ask you to confirm that you'd like to be added to the active leader roster.
- 9. If you do not have a current Wilderness First-Aid (WFA) or Mountaineering Oriented First-Aid (MOFA) badge, you must earn the badge or be signed up for a course within 1 year of earning your hike leader badge.

Mentor Requirements:

Mentor selected must be a current hike leader and have led a minimum of 4 club hikes.
