Head: HEENT, PERRL

Neck: JVD, TD, OD?

Shoulders, Clavicles

Chest: Normal movement, OD?

Abdomen: UL, UR, LR, LL, OD?

Pelvis: Consider Wrap

Limbs, Joints: Splint

Extremities: CMS

Back: Log roll on to pad

History- SAMPLE, OPQRST

Vitals- HR+Q(50-100), RR+Q(12-20), BP, SCTM
