First Aid committee: Bob Keranen

April 2nd WFA being offered and instructed by Bob and Steven Kollar. Registration is full with 16 on the waitlist. Course is structured using Base Medical and the course needs a separate CPR badge for functionality. Plans to offer a second course in a couple of months and eventually relaunch MOFA.

Snowshoe: Ruth Russel

Debrief of Snowshoe course this year. Overall went well and received good feedback. But a few lessons learned. The way the course was structured with the timing of it being posted and the cost of

the course, it filled quickly with students from other branches. The students liked the way the groups were ranked in a non-hierarchical way. The Zoom meeting was too long. There were lots of last-minute cancellations and students wanting to go on the field trips without attending the classes. The Base Camp link for the Avalanche presentation is a good resource and recommend adding low impact badge as a curriculum next year.
