
Climbing in the Chilliwack's

DIRECTIONS FOR APPROACH TO Paleface Creek Road turnoff and DEPOT CREEK ROAD double bridge @ mytopo.com ~30 miles on Chilliwack Lake Road AND TRAIL Steph Abegg, July 2012 L 21 × 60440 B Chilliwack Depot Creek Road turnoff Lake ~1.7 miles from bridge over Paleface Creek ~31.7 miles on Chilliwack Lake Road @ mytopo.com Drivable by most vehicles (as of July 2012). Normal parking spot -0.9 mi from Chilliwack Lake Road Bridge with yellow rails, Drivable by higher clearance vehicles blocked off as of July 2012 ~0.1 miles past Depot Creek (as of July 2012). Enter old-growth Drive I-5 north to Bellingham exit 256, follow signs to Sumas, forest and follow definite old Fork: take road going left into Depor Greek Trail cross border into Canada, take Transcanada Hwy 1 east. Drive 17 thicker forest (don't continue trail up Depot Creek valley miles and take the Vedder Road exit (#119A) going south. Drive straight on flat road), climb ~150 3.4 miles thru town and turn left onto the Chilliwack River Rd vards to higher road (just before bridge over river). Drive 31.7 miles on Chilliwack River Rd, which becomes unpaved and potholed for the section ~5 miles along the east side of Chilliwack Lake. Turn left onto narrow, dirt to Lake Ouzel... Depot Creek Rd (no sign) about 200 yards before bridge over Depot Creek. Finding Depot Creek Road and the Depot Creek Trail is somewhat confusing. See the map for further detail.
