Tying In – Butterfly knot clipped to harness with tails stuffed in pack

Tying-In – Tying in short with Kiwi Coil methods

Installing and stowing prusiks and other ascending devices

Pre-rigging and stowing pickets, ice screws and tools

Stowing gear – harness loops or gear sling

Mechanical Advantage Systems

- 3:1 Z-pulley
- 5:1 Complex – Option 1
- 5:1 Complex – Option 2
- 2:1 C-Pulley or (aka Drop C)
- 6:1 Convert Z-pulley to a C-on-Z
- 6:1 Convert Drop C to a Z-on-C
- 9:1 Z-on-Z
