 - Upper petals often form a hood



Family – Buttercup (Ranunculaceae)
Generally 5 distinct petals, 5 sepals,
numerous stamens and pistils




Drummonds Anemone

Family – Sunflower/Aster (Asteraceae)

- Flowers have a composite head – with ray flowers and disk flowers.
- Asters – bracts overlap like shingles.
- Daisys – bracts are the same length.

Family – Phlox (Polemoniaceae)

- Radial symmetry
- have 5 lobed petals and 5 stamens

- Compound, alternate, leaves
- 5 petals, 5 sepals, 15+ stamens
