Discoverlife is encyclopedic and has photos for many species of mosses. (Click on "Mosses" at top of page, then "Plant genera" under ID Nature Guides beneath the word Bryophyta. Moss families will appear. The left column is genera but appears not completed. Under group at the top check "Bryophytes" and then "Search". This narrows the left column to Bryophyte genera only. It would appear to get Bryophyte genera alphabetically past Heterocladium, one must search the families in the center of the page).
