Steps to becoming a hike leader:

1. **Recommendations**:

- o **Day Hikes**: Complete at least three day hikes with the Mountaineers within the past year. One of these hikes should be with the Tacoma Branch.
- o **Low Impact Recreation**: Complete the Low Impact Recreation Online Course.

2. Prerequisites (Complete in Any Order):

- New Hike & Backpack Leader Seminar: Attend this seminar—from any branch.
- Online Application: Submit your <u>Hike Leader Application</u> online. Be sure to specify Tacoma Branch. You should receive confirmation of your application within a few days.
- First Aid Training: Complete either Wilderness First Aid (WFA) or Medical First Aid (MOFA). Trail Emergency Preparedness is acceptable providing you complete either WFA or MOFA within one year.
- Navigation Training: Complete either the Wilderness (off-trail) Navigation or Staying Found (on-trail) navigation course.

3. Mentored Hike:

 Mentored Hike: The committee will approve a mentor, and then your final step is to successfully lead a mentored hike. The committee will then approve your Hike Leader Badge.

Steps to becoming a backpack leader:

1. Recommendations

o **Backpack Trips**: Complete one backpack trip with the Mountaineers.

2. Prerequisites (Complete in Any Order):

- o **Lead two day hikes:** Become a hike leader and lead two day hikes.
- o **Backpack Skills:** Earn a Basic Backpack Skills Badge.
- o **Online Application**: Submit your online <u>Backpack Leader Application</u>. You should receive confirmation of your application within a few days.
- Assistant Lead: Be an Assistant Lead on one Tacoma Branch backpack trip.
 Similar Mountaineer overnight trips from other committees may be accepted.

3. Mentored Backpack:

Mentored Backpack: The committee will approve a mentor, and then your final step is to successfully lead a mentored backpack. The committee will then approve your Backpack Leader Badge.

Additional Hike & Backpack Leader Information

• Urban Walk Leader Badge

 The Tacoma Branch does not currently offer the Urban Walk Leader Badge. If you're interested in becoming an Urban Walk Leader, please complete a separate application to a different branch.

• To Maintain your Hike and/or Backpack Leader Badge:

- o Hike leaders must lead at least two trips per year.
- o Backpack leaders must lead any combination of the following per year:
 - a. Two overnight trips OR
 - b. One day hike and one overnight backpack trip OR
 - c. One multi-night backpack trip.
- Be in adequate physical and mental condition to properly lead each hike or backpack scheduled.
- o Meet and follow the Minimum Club-wide Standards for Hiking and Backpacking as outlined on the Mountaineers website.

• Reimbursement of Expenses:

- The Committee will reimburse 50% of WFA or MOFA course for New Hike Leaders. To qualify, you must lead 3 hikes within 12 months of becoming a leader.
- The Committee will reimburse 50% of WFA or MOFA course recertification for Existing Hike Leaders. To qualify, you must be a Prior Year Key Leader or Super Volunteer. These badges are earned for leading a determined number of trips or volunteering a determined number of hours by The Mountaineers.
- o Please email reimbursement requests to any of the committee co-chairs.
