Directions to Marinas:

1. <u>Delin Dock Marina</u>, 1616 E. D St., Tacoma, WA 98402

From Tacoma on I-5, take I-705 /WA-7 toward City Center, Exit 133. Take the exit for the Tacoma Dome/East 26th Street. Turn right on east 26th Street. Take second left on D Street. Marina is on the left. Small parking lot is by permit only, so park on the street. Call your skipper when you park for access through the gate.

2. <u>Des Moines Yacht Club/Three Tree Point Yacht Club/Des Moines Marina</u> 22737 Marine View Dr S, Des Moines, WA 98198

From Tacoma on I-5, merge onto WA-516 W/S Kent Des Moines Rd toward Des Moines. Continue straight on Marine View Drive S. Turn left on S. 227th Street. Park in lot near restaurant or marina depending on where boat is moored. Call your skipper when you park for access through the gate.

3. Foss Harbor Marina, 821 Dock Street, Tacoma, WA 98402.

Northbound I-5, take exit 133, and turn RIGHT onto Ramp towards I-705/WA-7/City Center/Mt. Rainier. Keep LEFT to stay on ramp towards City Center/Tacoma Dome. Get into RIGHT lane & follow Schuster Parkway Signs. Keep in LEFT lane. At the first light, turn RIGHT onto 4th St., which turns into Dock Street. Follow until you arrive at 821 Dock Street.

Southbound I-5, take exit 133, turn RIGHT onto Ramp towards I-705/WA-7/City Center. Keep RIGHT and stay on Ramp. Follow ramp to the LEFT onto I-705 towards I-705/City Center. Get into RIGHT lane & follow Schuster Parkway Signs. Follow directions as listed above for northbound.

Marina will be on the left side of the road just past Foss Waterway Seaport, but parking at marina is permit only. Look for parking along street before marina or in pay lot and walk to marina. Call your skipper when you park for access through the gate.

4. Johnny's Dock, 1900 East D St, Tacoma, WA, 98421

From Tacoma on I-5, merge onto Hwy 16 Gig Harbor Bremerton via exit 132, Take 6th Avenue Exit 3 towards W/163 N Ruston heading toward Point Defiance, turn left at the exit, right on Pearl Street, W/163N, turn slight right onto Pearl Street W/163, park in the lot signed "Marina Parking" just before Point Defiance ferry toll booth and walk down to N Waterfront Drive. Turn left and look for the ramp just before the Breakwater marina office. Call your skipper when you park for access through the gate.

5. Marina at Brown's Point, 5618 Marine View Drive, Tacoma, WA 98422

From Tacoma on I-5, take exit 133 towards downtown Tacoma on #705, exit onto Highway 509 which turns into Marine View Drive around Commencement Bay, water will always be to your left. This turns into a single lane road, so allow extra driving time. Just as Marine View Dr starts to turn right up hill, marina entry turns downhill to left. Entry way is locked - call your skipper when you arrive so you can drive in.

6. Tacoma Yacht Club, 5401 N Waterfront Dr, Tacoma, WA 98407

From Tacoma on I-5, merge onto Hwy 16 Gig Harbor Bremerton via exit 132, Take 6th Avenue Exit 3 towards W/163 N Ruston heading toward Point Defiance, turn left at the exit, right on Pearl Street, W/163N, turn right on N 51st St, at first round-about go 3/4 way around and enter drive marked Tacoma Yacht Club. Let guard at gatehouse know name of skipper you will be sailing with. Call your skipper when you park for access through the gate to the boat.

7. Swantown Marina, 1022 Marine Drive NE, Olympia, WA 98501

Driving Northbound I-5

- 1 Take Port of Olympia Exit 105. Stay right, following the Port of Olympia signs on Henderson Boulevard.
- 2 Turn left at the traffic light onto Plum Street.
- 3 Go through 5 traffic lights. The last light will be State Avenue.
- 4 After crossing State Avenue, turn left onto Olympia Avenue, just past the Shell Gas Station.
- Olympia Avenue forks right. Swantown Boatworks will be on your right just before the fork. Stay to the right and it becomes Marine Drive which will take you to the Swantown Marina Office. The office will be on your right.

Driving Southbound I-5

- 1 Take Exit 105B. Stay right and follow the Port of Olympia signs onto Plum Street.
- 2 Go through 6 traffic lights. The last light will be State Avenue.
- 3 After crossing State Avenue, turn left onto Olympia Avenue, just past the Shell Gas Station.
- 4 Olympia Avenue forks right. Swantown Boatworks will be on your right just before the fork. Stay to the right and it will become Marine Drive which will take you to the Swantown Marina Office. The office will be on your right.

Instructions for Sails:

A. Bring your Sailing Essentials:

- 1. Non-skid deck shoes (or sea boots) with non-marking soles.
- 2. Heavy-duty gloves for line handling (fingertips cut off is OK).

- 3. Warm clothing head to foot (Note: The ambient temperature on the water is usually lower than on land).
- 4. Foul-weather gear-layers are good
- 5. Sunglasses
- 6. Sunscreen
- 7. Knife on lanyard
- 8. Whistle on a lanyard
- 9. Food and drink
- 10. Flashlight
- 11. Bring your form for skipper signature for each sail. Point of Sail chart is often helpful.
- B. <u>Call the skipper at least one hour prior to the activity to confirm that the activity is ongoing</u>-may have to cancel or change dates due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances. This will also confirm that you will be attending.
- C. Please arrive on time for sailing sessions. All boats are secured in some manner, with a security guard or gate. Please call the skipper when you arrive and you will be met at gated locations and allowed in.
