

South Sound Inlets

- To earn the South Sound Inlets Award each of the seven trips must include paddling at least seven miles of unrepeated shoreline within the inlet.
- Miles paddled while crossing from shore to shore does not count towards the minimum seven miles of shoreline.
- This award could be achieved without exceeding an SKII+ rating (“+”=crossings up to 1 nm & currents >1 knot/<2 knots), or a 10 NM total paddle distance.
- Though not required, we encourage you to include exploration of the innermost tidal areas as part of your trip.
- The practice of car shuttling is allowed.
